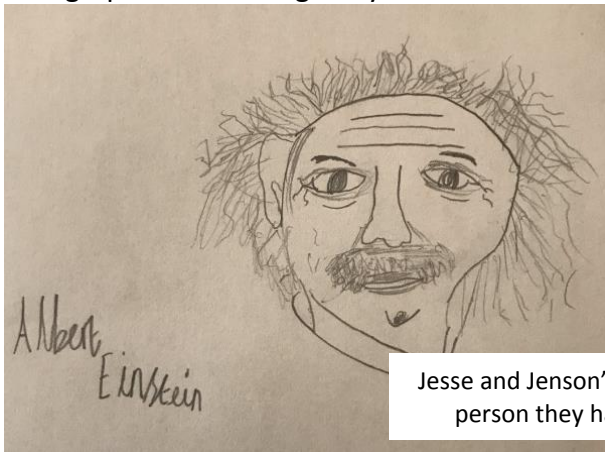

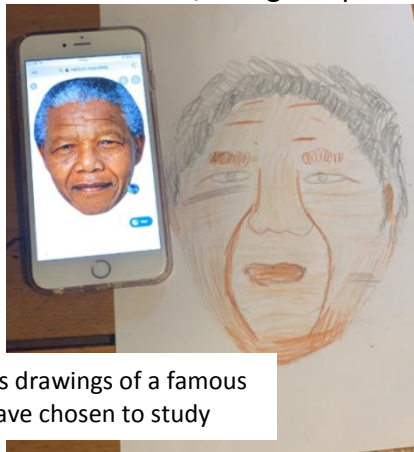
Dear Parents/Carers

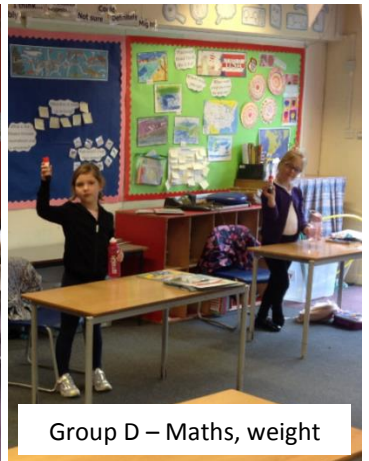

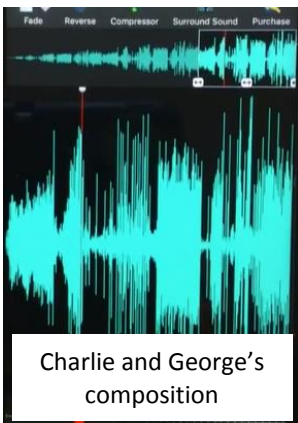
